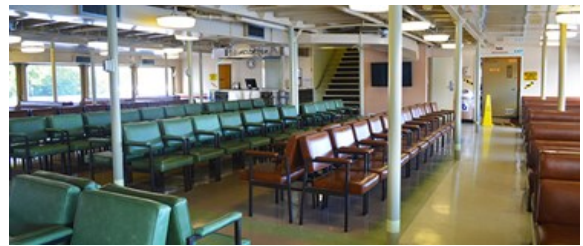
Red Lion Hotel

M.V. Coho - This vehicle and passenger ferry crosses the Strait of Juan de Fuca between Victoria's Inner Harbour and Port Angeles in Washington State. On board the vessel floor to ceiling windows, easily accessible outside decks provide passengers with great views of the Olympic Peninsula and the wildlife that live in and around the Strait of Juan de Fuca. Ship amenities include a gift shop, featuring an array of unique gifts that reflect the essence of the west coast, and a cafeteria that serves a wide variety of hot and cold food and beverage items, including specialty sandwiches and soft ice cream.
